Important Guidelines for Taste of Dogwood

1. All levels are welcome to enjoy demos for each activity. If your dog has experience with an activity (even if just at camp), feel free to come and join in for just a little “taste” of what is to come over the weekend.
2. Some instruction for beginners may be offered, but please know these particular sessions are more for campers to get acquainted with staff and the various activities, rather than being designed for more serious skill building and training.
3. If this is your first time at camp, please know that your dog may be stressed and that jumping right into activities may be a bit overwhelming, feel free to rotate amongst the offerings to observe, get to meet other campers, and participate when appropriate. Please pace your dog – we would hate for there to be an injury on the first day of camp.
4. Only one dog per person for each activity, if you plan on participating. For demos, you can bring more.
5. Dogs **MUST** remain on-leash for all sessions except for Beach Time and when a staff member instructs you to unleash your dog.
