### LYME DISEASE INFORMATION

**EXPOSURE:** Lyme disease is a bacterial infection transmitted by the bite of a deer tick, found on all types of vegetation and animals, especially in the woods. The deer tick is most active in the spring and fall, and present throughout the summer.

PRECAUTION: Wear long sleeves and pants. An insect repellent such as Deep Woods OFF!® can help repel ticks.

Brush off clothing and pets before going inside. Check yourself and pets carefully for ticks.

Remove attached tick at once with fine-jaw tweezers by grasping tick's head as close to skin as possible and gently pulling straight out. Be careful not to squeeze tick's body as this may cause it to inject fluid into you. Wash bite area and apply antiseptic.

**SYMPTOMS:** A ring-shaped rash may occur within 4-20 days. Symptoms may include fever, chills, headache, stiffness in joints, weakness and fatigue. Common symptoms of Lyme Disease may mimic arthritis. In some cases there are no symptoms.

**DIAGNOSIS:** Contact your doctor if you suspect Lyme Disease, or its symptoms. **TREATMENT:** If detected early, Lyme Disease is usually treatable with antibiotics.

#### From Chicago Metropolitan Area

- 94 West towards Milwaukee.
- Take 894 bypass around Milwaukee and connect back to 94 West towards Madison.
- Remain on 94 West and look for the signs to the Wisconsin Dells.
- OR
- 90 West toward Rockford.
- Remain on 90 West and look for the signs to the Wisconsin Dells
- 90 and 94 will eventually merge to form 90/94 towards the Wisconsin Dells.
- \*\*Approaching the Wisconsin Dells, take exit 89 (Lake Delton/Reedsburg exit).
- Exit east towards Lake Delton
- Follow Highway 23 to and make a <u>left</u> onto Wisconsin Dells Parkway (Traffic Light here). (This will be at Denny's Restaurant/KFC)
- After approximately ½ -¾ mile, turn left on Newsom (at the *Citgo* Gas Station/Subway).
- Newsom will end quickly. Turn right onto Clara Avenue
- Perlstein will be on your left around the bend. Please take our driveway slowly as we have many wild friends (deer in-particular) who like to visit.

I understand that participation in Camp Dogwood, Inc. (herein referred to as "camp") is not without risk, harm, or damage to myself, my dog(s), or my property. Although health and safety precautions will be taken, factors such as: the personalities of dog(s), the level of dog handling experience of others, the various types of physical activities, and the unpredictable nature of animals pose a certain level of risk beyond the control of Camp Dogwood, Inc. Camp Dogwood, Inc. does not assume responsibility for any aspect of the safety of human participants, dogs, or property. My participation in camp is done voluntarily and based on my assessment of my dog(s) and my own abilities. I assume full responsibility for any and all risks that my dog(s) and I may encounter while at camp.

I hereby waive and release Camp Dogwood, Inc., its employees, owners, agents, and volunteers from any and all liability of any nature, for injury or damage which my dog(s) or I may suffer including specifically, but not limited to, any injury or damage resulting from my actions, those of the dog(s) I control, or the actions of others or the dog(s) they control. I expressly assume the risk of any such damage or injury while participating in this camp, or on the grounds, or in the surrounding area.

I certify that the following statements are true and correct and that Camp Dogwood, Inc. relied upon the truthfulness of information I provided in order to allow myself and my dog(s) to participate in the camp program:

- 1. I am 18 years of age or older.
